## Set sail for success on the Torrens

A GROUP of disabled children and adults gathered to sail on the River Torrens yesterday as a way of encouraging their active involvement in the community.

About 35 SCOSA clients - in specially designed boats for the disabled - turned out for Sailability on the Torrens at

Elder Park. The event was to promote yachting among disabled people, with the participants putting into practice what they had learned in summer sailing workshops.

SCOSA chief executive Nicole Graham said the event was about showing the public disabled peo-

ple were just as capable as everyone else.

She said it provided them with "meaningful engagement" with other people. "Our clients love it. It's an opportunity for them to experience something different and showcase their abilities," she said.
