## Thieves Steal from Spastic Centre

Thoughtless and callous thieves have broken into a Northern suburbs takeaway shop and stolen money from a charity collection ball.

**scosa**, the **Spastic Centres of South Australia**, were disappointed at the heartless actions of thieves who broke into the Heights Chicken and Takeaway store at Walkley Heights in the early hours of the morning last Wednesday.

The thieves smashed through the front door and used a rock to break the bright orange **scosa** collection ball stealing an unknown amount of cash which was to be put towards providing support and services to people with disabilities in South Australia.
